COVID-19 CHECK-IN/OUT MEASURES FOR YOUR INFORMATION

BASE PERSONNEL: Our base personnel are briefed and trained on hygiene standards while working.

CLEANING PROCEDURE: The interior and exterior of all yachts will be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected, with particular attention to high contact areas such as door handles, pump handles, steering wheels, cupboards, dashboards, galley items, etc.

CHECK-IN PROCEDURE

- Only the skipper/charterer should present themselves onboard for the check-in with one of our base personnel the rest of the guests/crew need to observe social distancing guidelines and wait to board until instructed.
- All guests/crew should wear a facemask and sanitise their hands.
- Social distancing of **1.5m** should be applied between our base personnel and the skipper/charterer.
- In addition to the standard charter paperwork (charter party and crew list), a **health declaration questionnaire** must be completed before embarkation.
- All guests/crew must do <u>a rapid COVID-19 test</u> in one of the authorised health centres in Volos (if chartering from our Volos Base) or Skopelos (if chartering from our Loutraki Base) before departure from the port (arranged by SAIL AEGEAN at check-in), <u>unless they have</u>

(1) a valid negative PCR molecular test result performed within 72 hours of embarkation, or

(2) **proof of recovery from the SARS-CoV-2 virus infection** in the past 2-9 months, issued by a public authority or a certified laboratory, or

(3) **a COVID-19 vaccination certificate** (proving that the second/final dose was given at least 14 days before embarkation).

CHECK-OUT PROCEDURE

• Only the skipper/charterer can take part in the technical briefing with one of our base personnel the rest of the guests/crew need to observe social distancing guidelines and exit the yacht until instructed to go back onboard.

WHILE ON BOARD

- Local emergency numbers will be provided.
- A 500ml bottle of alcohol-based hand santiser will be provided.
- A **thermometer and pulse oximeter** will be provided Greek regulations state that the readings of each guest/crew member should be recorded daily.
- All guests/crew should **follow the guidelines** found on board regarding incident management and personal protection measures (e.g. frequently **washing hands** with soap and water, opening of hatches whenever possible to make sure the area is well **ventilated**, etc).
- At the end of the charter, the guests/crew are required to dispose of their **rubbish** (from bathrooms and galley).
