

First night in Volos... the tsipouradiko is a must!

The famous tsipouradika, tavernas specialising in the ouzo-like tsipouro spirit that is accompanied by a wide variety of seafood appetizers, are the trademark of the region.



Local delicacies and specialities of Pelion and the Gulf



Pelion produces great quantities of flavoursome fruits, such as apples, pears, cherries, peaches, oranges, figs, chestnuts and many more. These are cultivated by the locals organically and sold in the villages. Many locals also use these to produce the traditional **spoon sweets** (fruit preserves) and jams. These make good gifts or souvenirs for bringing back home, along with local olive treats and dried herbs and teas from Mount Pelion.

Spetzofai – Pelion's speciality. A rustic spicy dish of thick local sausages and peppers in tomato sauce - best found in the mountain villages but also possible to find in coastal villages.

Crayfish Spaghetti and Octopus Stifado at **Isalos** taverna - in the little fishing harbour on the island of Trikeri.

Generally, many good seaside tavernas can be found around the Gulf. In the charming little village of Kato Gatzea, **Kamares** offers a tasty variety of seafood and meat dishes. Great news for vegetarians...this place has an amazing aubergine dish! A meat version of this also exists.

A Word of Advice...

When ordering seafood, such as calamari, octopus and shrimps, it is recommended that you ask in the restaurant whether it is fresh (not frozen). Enquire about the local fish of the day.

For tsipouro and meze. Along the waterfront of Volos, next to our yachts.

Highly recommended Greek cuisine, hidden away in Volos.

Modern Greek cuisine in Volos.

Me Zen

Modern and gastronomic take on the tsipouradiko in Volos.

Xenia Domotel Volos

Drinks on the rooftop terrace of the Yacht Club.

Kritsa Restaurant

A welcoming gastronomic highlight in the lovely Pelion village of Portaria.

La Veranda Restaurant

Smart hotel restaurant, offering a stunning view of Volos and the Pagasitikos in the village of Portaria.

Aeriko or Art Café

Coffee and cake with a scenic view in Portaria and Makrinitza.

Stathmos Restaurant

Local cuisine in the Pelion village of Milies.

O Manolas

Perfect for fresh seafood - at Agia Kiriaki, as you exit the Pagasitikos Gulf.

Tseta

Seafood taverna in the large unspoilt bay of Kottes.

Tasty, local rustic "Skopelitiki" cheese pie, other traditional pies and Greek coffees. Hidden in the little streets in Skopelos Town, you might have to ask a local for directions.

Hidden in Skopelos town

There are many restaurants on the waterfront of Skopelos town but if you want to get away from the more "touristy" restaurants in the port, take a walk to the Venetian castle. There, you can enjoy dinner at the **Anatolia Restaurant**, while listening to live Greek Rembetiko music with a perfect view over the town and the island of Alonissos. It is highly recommended that you call to book a table in advance.

Go for a wander in the Old Town of Alonissos

Once you have anchored in the charming port of Alonissos, Patitiri, why not take a scenic walk to the old town of Alonissos (30-minutes) to build up your appetite. Alternatively, you can get a 10-minute bus ride from the port to the old town, situated at the top of the hill above Patitiri. When wandering around, you will discover impressive views, traditional stone houses along charming alleyways, as well as good food. You will also find local artists' shops and many cafés.

For typical Greek meat dishes, taste the kontosouvli at **Kastro** Restaurant. If you're lucky, you might get a table in the ruins of the kastro (castle), under the glimmering stars with a panoramic view of Alonissos and its neighbouring uninhabited islands.

If you're after something sweet or just simply want to enjoy a refreshing drink or cocktail, check out **Hayiati** Patisserie and Piano-bar. You can enjoy gorgeous views, especially at sunset, and sometimes accompanied by live music.

If you're just staying in the port of Alonissos, be sure to go for a coffee or indulge in yummy comfort food and Greek delicatessen at **Mavros Gatos**.
